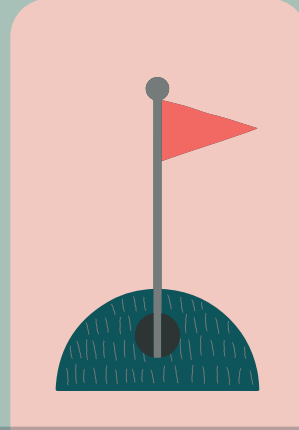
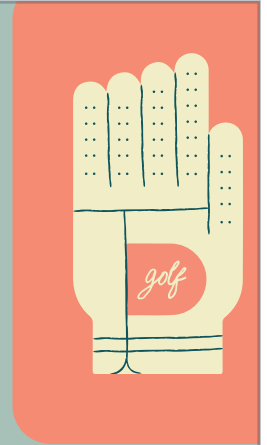

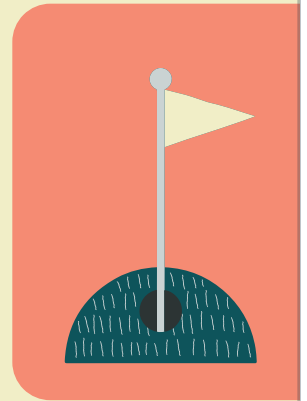


Welcome to the 2026 Season of the Working Women's Golf League! We are excited to launch another summer of fun, friendship, and fairways with an incredible group of women.

Introduction to VP Role

1. Supporting the President communicating with the golf courses and pros,
2. Working with the President to determine any communications needed to members regarding inclement weather on league night,
3. Supporting league members with any questions on league night,
4. Taking the lead to organize the End of Year Member Banquet,
5. Assisting the President with planning and organizing the End of Year Tournament,
6. Supporting the Treasurer by providing relevant content for the website and social media, and
7. Providing support to help with delivery of scorecards, questions about scoring or fun-night golf play/rules.

Pro Shop – Tips For Smooth League Nights



- 18-hole Shotgun Start
 - Arrive at least 20 minutes early
 - Get Food, Drinks, Cart, Socialize
 - Head to assigned hole
 - Cart Staging
 - Tee off promptly at 6:00 p.m.
- Pace of Play – WWGL is a social league, but pace of play matters so we can finish before dark . . .and the sprinklers!

Sean Thomsen, the PGA Head Pro at Pinecrest, provided details about the changes to the format this year.

A key point is that we all have to be at our assigned holes and ready to tee off promptly at 6:00 p.m.

For those who like to walk, all of the courses have agreed to provide a complimentary staging of carts that you can take to your starting hole if needed. You'll simply leave your cart at the starting hole and bring it back to the clubhouse when you finish your 9-holes. This should really help for those holes that are a good distance to walk from the clubhouse.

If you are riding in a cart for the full 9 holes, you will need to pay for your cart usage as usual. Sean mentioned you can pay in advance if you'd like or can pay week to week.

He finished his presentation with a golf trivia game and gave out sleeves of golf balls for the correct answers.

2026 League Format



- 18-hole Shotgun Start
- Group A and Group B partner teams randomly matched into 4-person groups each week
- Team Assignments / Rotate Courses every week - on the website
- Groups will Rotate Front/Back start every 3 weeks - allows all to play front and back over the season

Swing Smart

This year, instead of Tuesday night teams and Wednesday night teams, there will be group A and group B. Teams will not cross over into the other group.

Your team has been assigned a number. Teams one through 20 are in Group A and Teams 21 through 38 are in Group B, and as always, your team will be paired with another team in your group to play as a foursome.

On the website you will find your team number as well as the full schedule for the league including the dates, the courses, your starting hole and the pairings.

Group A will start on the front nine, Group B on the back, and then every three weeks, the groups will switch. Simply pay attention to your starting holes, and you will be in the right place.

The website has all the correct information and is the official resource for the league this year.

If there happens to be inclement and/or dangerous weather, it is the responsibility of the leadership team to decide if the round should be canceled. If able, we will post it to the website in the Important Updates section.

If a decision to cancel is made on-site, you will be informed via horn sound or if needed, someone will drive the course to remove the teams.

Fun Game Nights



There will be (3) Fun Game Nights - (1) at each course.

May 26 - Pinecrest - Alternate Shot Format

June 23 - Sage Lakes - Chapman Format

July 21 - Sand Creek - 2-person Scramble Format

In order to be able to have a different "Fun Game Night" at each golf course, these will take place every four weeks.

For those of you who are new to the league these "fun nights" give us a chance to change things up and play in different formats. You earn points for these fun nights separately from regular play and at the end of the season additional payouts are awarded.

Instructions for each format are on the website and will also be distributed with the scorecards on the fun game nights.

Scoring Review

SCORING DURING PLAY

Each 2-person team will swap scorecards with the other 2-person team on their hole. Count each stroke (drives and fairways, then putts). 10 strokes maximum. If you hit 10 strokes, you stop counting putts and instead put an X for putts on each subsequent hole.

CONFIRM SCORE

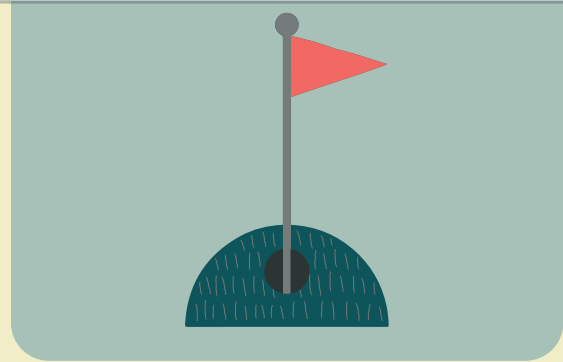
With your playing partners, confirm final score, adding up total strokes and putts. A representative from each partner team signs the scorecard as confirmation.

SUBMIT SCORECARD

At each course there will be a WWGL box designated for scorecards. Please submit once the round is completed and scorecard is confirmed.

SCORECARD COLLECTION

A member of the leadership team will collect the scorecards. All scores will be posted online weekly at idahofallswvgl.com and social media sites.



We reviewed how we score for this league.

Points are awarded for low rounds and for low putts each week, so we count both and note them separately on the scorecard.

We play to a maximum of 10 strokes each hole to try to keep play moving.

If you get your ball in the cup on the 10th stroke, you continue to count your putts for that hole and remaining holes.

If at any time on the 10th stroke your putt does not go into the cup, you mark a 10 for that hole and cease counting putts for the rest of the round.

Be sure to have a player from each team sign each scorecard before turning them in.

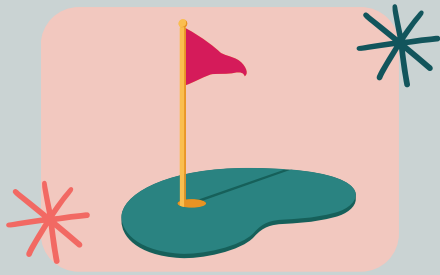
We do verify the math on each scorecard. If the math is incorrect, it will be corrected before the points are awarded.

This year the points will be posted each week on our website and our social media sites (Facebook and Instagram).

Stay Informed!

We reviewed the website and where information is located.

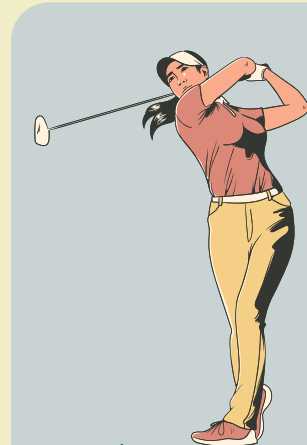
The weekly golf scores and any important notices will be posted on the website.

It is the primary place to go for information on the league.

We stressed the importance of reviewing the current bylaws, especially in the appendices about Pace of Play and Ready Golf. We do play Ready Golf for this league.

Substitute Players

- Try to plan ahead - it's never too early to find a substitute player.
- Substitute Player List will be posted on the website and password protected. Can use this listing to contact subs directly and is the preferred method for identifying subs.
- You can send a text or email to the substitute player(s) directly.
- If you post on the Facebook page for a sub, remember the algorithms don't always promptly show the posting to members.
- It is your responsibility to find a sub if you cannot play on a scheduled league night.



Game for Life!

We talked about what to do if you will not be able to play on any given week this season.

In order to keep play moving, we require members to make every effort to find a substitute to play if they will be absent.

The substitute list is in the password protected area of the website and was also distributed in the swag bags.

Texting, emailing, or calling a substitute directly is the quickest and most effective way to find a substitute.

The algorithms on Facebook don't always promptly show the posting to members in time for a substitute to see the post and respond.

It is each player's responsibility to find a substitute if you cannot play on a scheduled league night. Not showing up to play and not finding a sub can lead to removal from the league.

This year we even have a few subs who are going to use as many Tue nights as they can as "range practice" nights and will try to be at the courses just in case someone needs a last-minute sub.

It is still each player's responsibility to utilize your best efforts to make sure you have a substitute. If you cannot get one, please reach out to a member of leadership ASAP.

If for some reason a sub has an emergency and cannot play after agreeing to sub, they need to work with the player they are subbing for to find another sub.

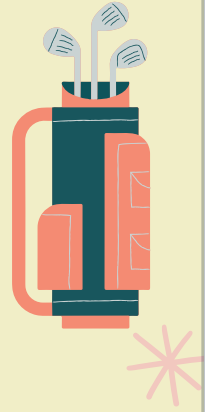

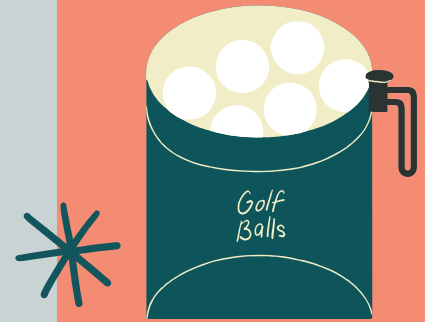

We will have a End of Year Tournament and a End of Year Banquet.

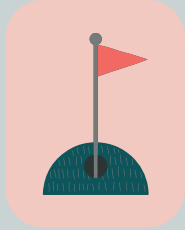
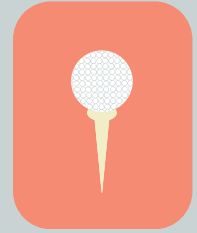
